Re: Anti-Dumping Investigation Concerning Float Glass Imported from Turkey - Preliminary Determination

1. Please be advised that, according to Article 28(a) of the Israeli Trade Levies and Safeguard Measures Law, 1991 (the "Law"), I have made an affirmative preliminary determination in the above investigation regarding dumping and consequent injury to a domestic industry.
2. In addition, I have found that provisional measures are necessary to prevent injury to the domestic industry during the course of the investigation.
3. Accordingly, I have asked the Israel Customs to require provisional security from the importers of the goods under investigation produced in Turkey, upon release from Custom. The products concerned and the rate of the provisional security are as follows:
