## RE: Notification of Initiation of an Investigation concerning the extension of the Anti-Dumping duty on the importation of Float Glass from Turkey

- Please be advised that on November 26, 2019, and in accordance with Article 32.26(b) of the Israeli Trade Levies and Safeguard Measures Law, 1991 (the "Law"), I have decided to initiate an investigation concerning the extension of the Anti-Dumping duty on the importation of Float Glass from Turkey (the "New Investigation").
- 2. The goods under investigation are imported under the Harmonized System Tariff Number: 70.05.2990
- 3. According to Article 32.26(e) of the Law, the above duty shall remain in effect until the Minister makes a decision pursuant to the provisions of section 32.29 (c). Attached herewith are:
  - (i) The decision to initiate the new investigation (in Hebrew).
  - (ii) A Questionnaire for manufacturers who wish to be part of the investigation (in English).
- 4. Any interested parties may present their claims and provide information within 30 days from the day of notice.
- 5. If you so wish, you may forward the above material to any additional interested parties in order to ensure that they have the full opportunity to submit their views within the time limit set.
